REGULATORS

I. Reserve Bank of India

1. Proposal submitted to RBI for establishing institution arrangement on Information System's (IS) audit
2. Discussion regarding Audit Quality Parameters with Shri Arnab Kumar Choudhury and Shri Rajnish Kumar CGM, RBI

The RBI informed that there is a need for establishing an institutional set-up (something similar to the ICAI), which is for Chartered Accountants (CAs) to carry out financial audits. This new set-up should be able to create a pool of professionals (CAs and non-CAs) as IS auditors by conducting rigorous examinations. In addition, it may also be ensured that these professionals are up to date with the latest technologies and methodologies. Accordingly, a proposal was submitted jointly with Digital Accounting and Assurance Board (DAAB) to RBI.

A meeting was held with Shri Arnab Kumar Choudhury, CGM Incharge, RBI and Shri Rajnish Kumar, CGM, Department of Supervision on 3rd August 2023 in Mumbai to discuss matters of professional interest including Audit Quality parameters. During the meeting RBI was apprised of various activities undertaken by ICAI including various meetings held with SCAs, Independent Directors, CFOs etc. alongwith RBI.

RBI sought inputs from the ICAI on issues and challenges faced by various stakeholders pertaining to the statutory audit of UCBs. Detailed inputs and suggestions were submitted to RBI after thorough brainstorming sessions from domain experts.

Further, in the continuous efforts to improve the MEF processes, the PDC has introduced a new feature known as the "Category Calculator". This feature has helped the MEF applicants in knowing the Category as per the revised norms of RBI dated 6th March 2023.

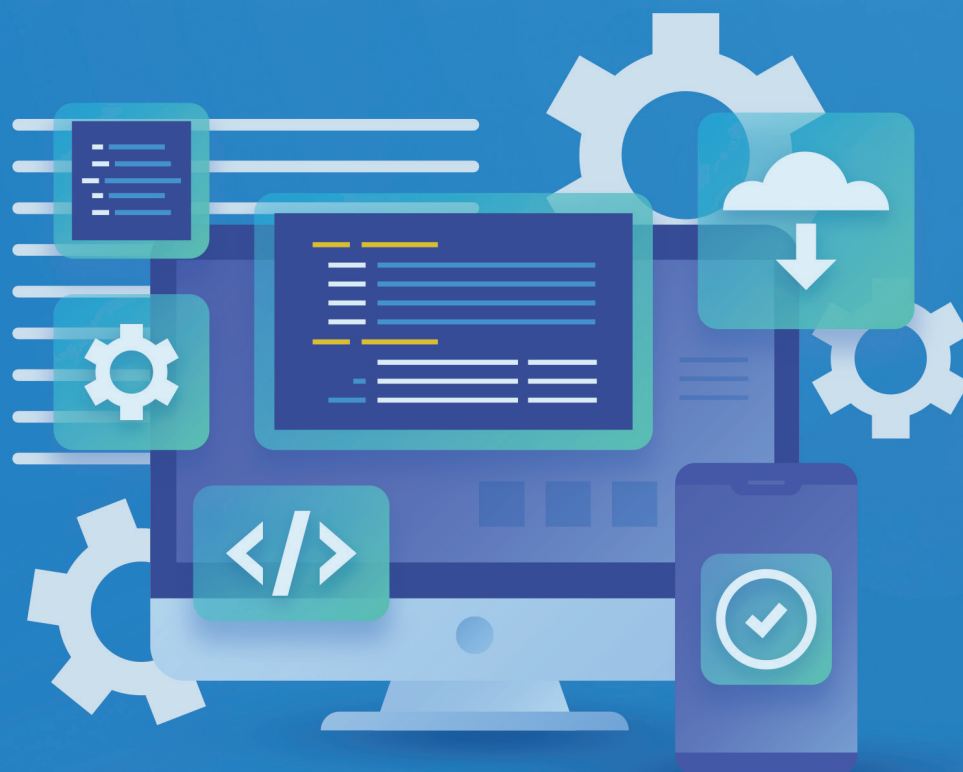
Red Flag System

An automated system to examine the financial data of the MEF applicants and criteria for generating red flags (exceptions) has been developed. By adopting the said automated red flag system, the Professional Development Committee has achieved a significant milestone of 100% verification of the Financial documents received from MEF applicants. This innovation streamlines the auditing process overall and speeds it up while simultaneously improving accuracy and compliance.

Automated Audit Allotment Software

In an effort to streamline the audit allotment mechanism on PAN India basis across the different sectors wherein the audit and assurance functions are being extended by the fraternity, PDC has introduced an Automated Auditors Allotment System (AAAS) wherein the allotment of Auditor's can now be made taking into consideration the location, experience, seniority, rotation, waiting list etc. without manual intervention.

The software was utilized by 5 public sector banks and this year Life Insurance Corporation alongwith Bank of India and Bank of Maharashtra expressed keen interest in the Automated Auditors Allotment System (AAAS).

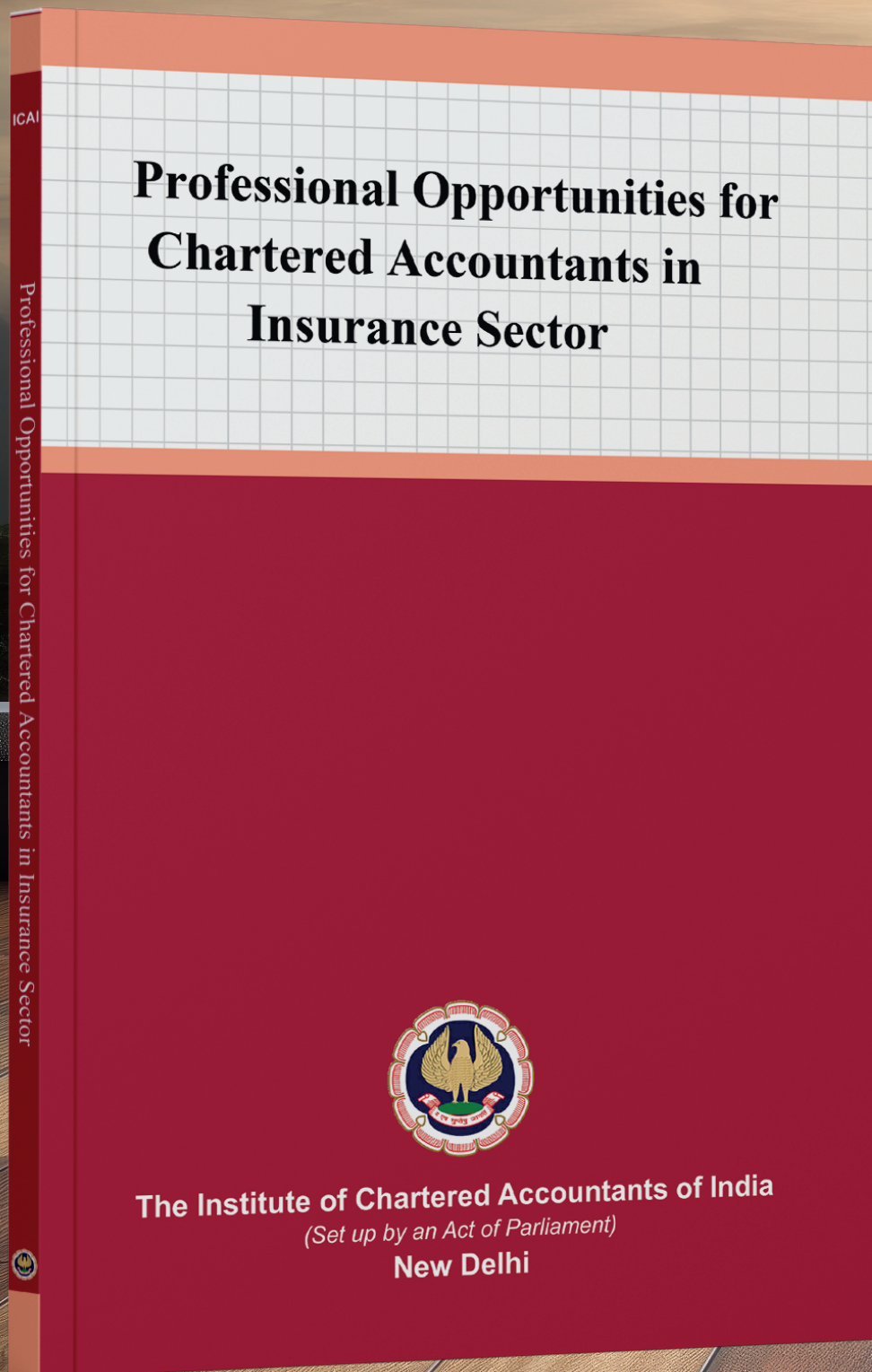

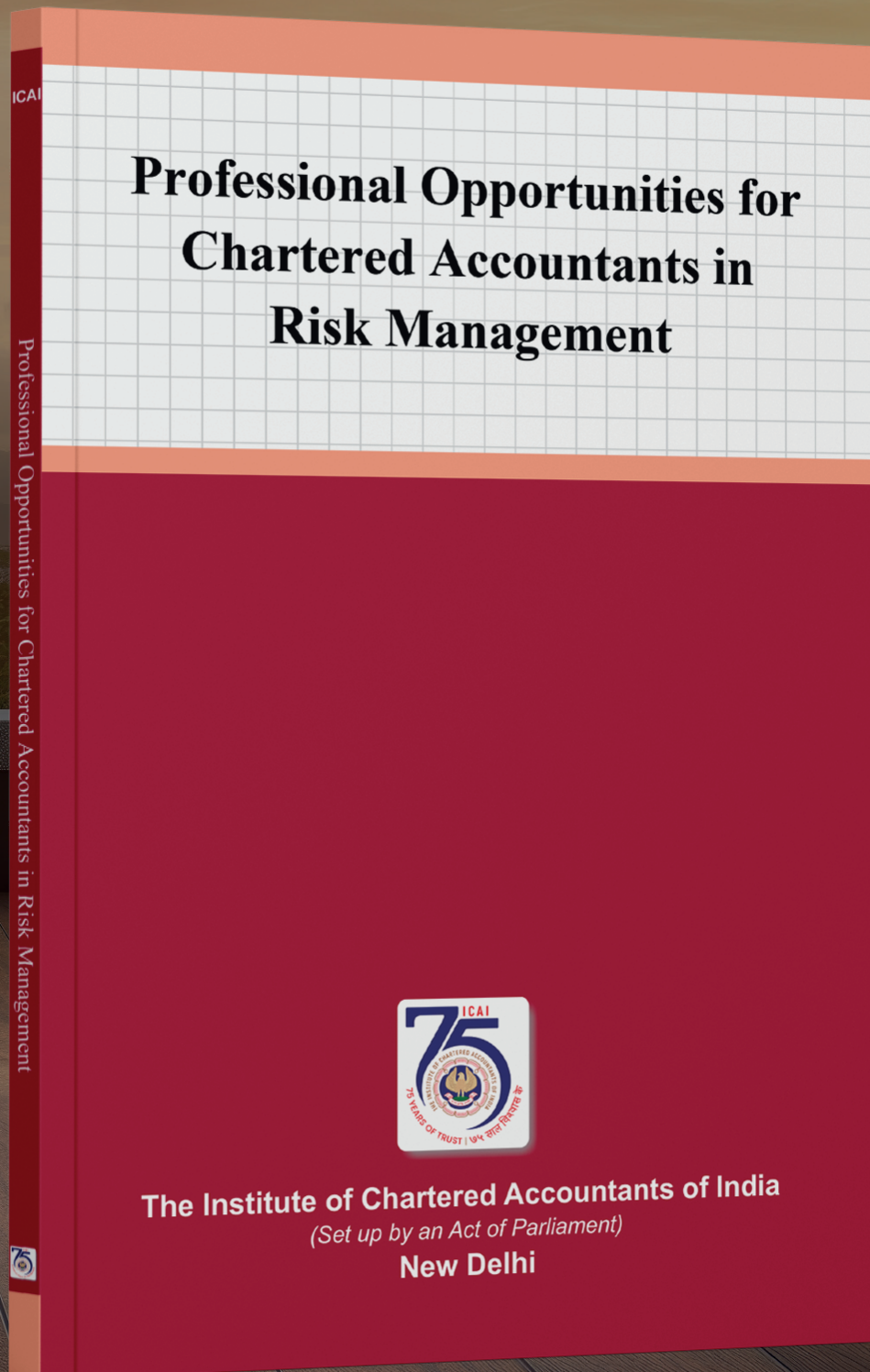

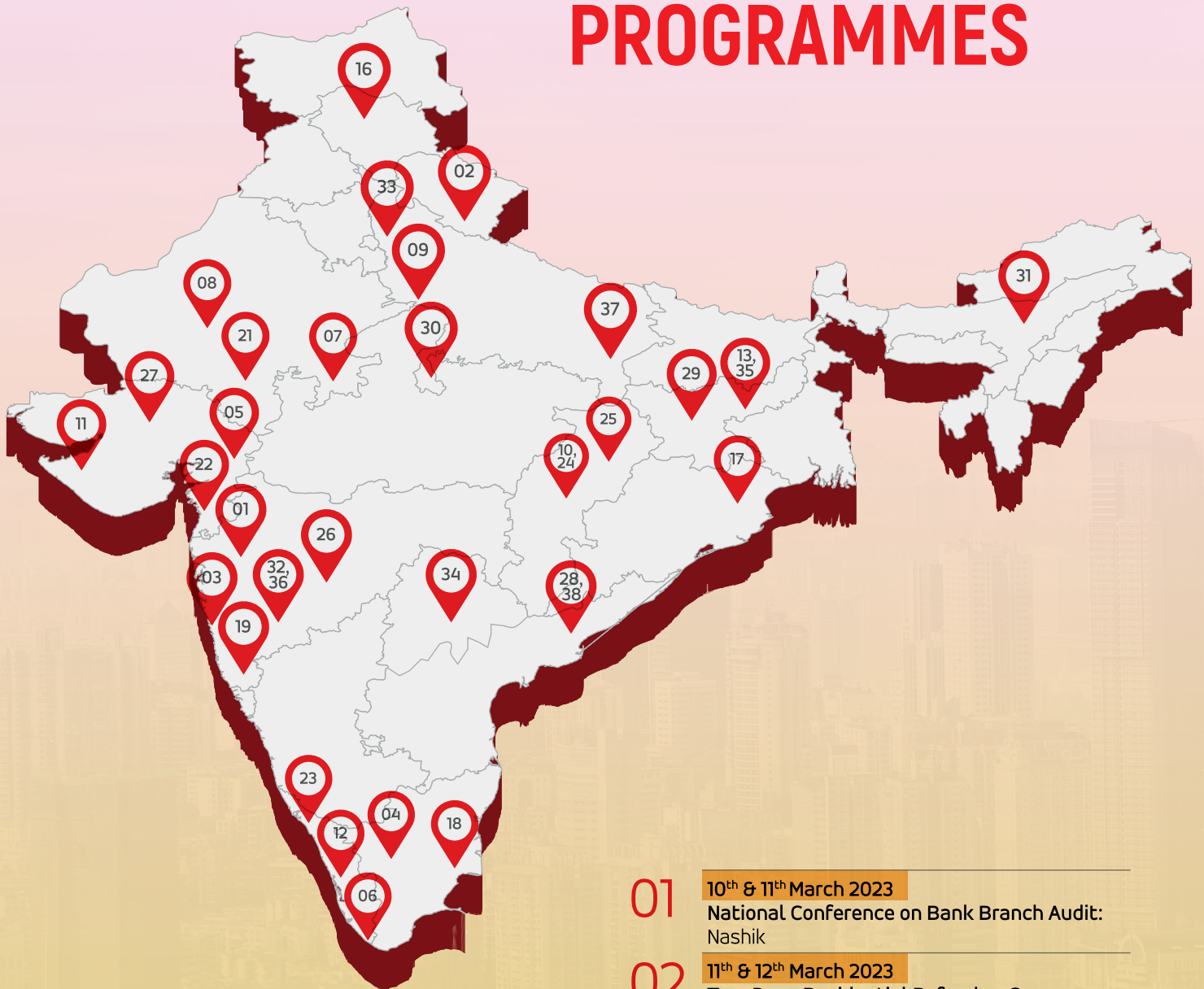

STATE LEVEL COORDINATION COMMITTEE (SLCC)/ SUB-SLCC MEETINGS

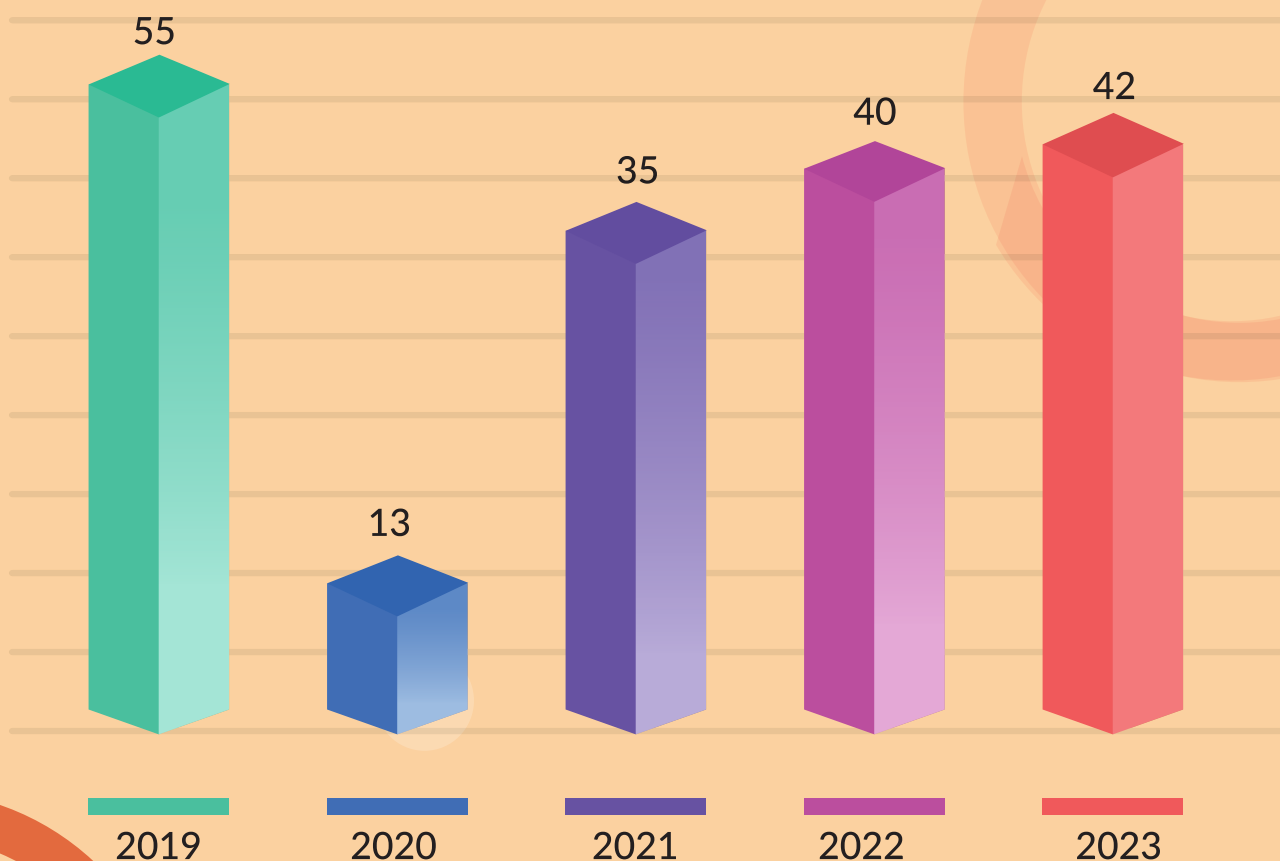
The Reserve Bank of India holds quarterly meetings of State Level Coordination Committee to regulate Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) and deposit accepted activities of incorporated bodies (UIBs) at each of their regional offices.

Such meetings are convened by Regional Director of respective regional office of RBI and attended by Principal Secretary/Secretaries of various departments such as

Finance, Home, Law etc. of respective states, National Housing Board (NHB), Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI), Registrar of Companies (RoC), Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDA), Registrar of Chit Fund, Department of Chit Fund and the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI).

More than 40 SLCC/ Sub-SLCC meetings were held during the year and were attended by the representatives of ICAI

INITIATIVE FOR MEMBERS

1. Advisory issued to SCAs and CFOs regarding fixation of the fees for all other items of work done on 31st March 2023

Reserve Bank of India has issued a circular dated 1st March, 2023 on Remuneration payable to the Statutory Central Auditors (SCAs) and Statutory Branch Auditors (SBAs) from Financial year 2022-23 wherein the remuneration payable to SBAs has been increased *10% across all the slabs pertaining to Para no 2.3 which is related to "Fees for all other items of work done by Statutory Auditors". Post the issue of the said circular, the PDC of the Institute was in receipt of various requests from the SCAs and the banks for bringing standardization in the fee structure for the various certifications provided and other works carried out during the Statutory Audit as the ACBs of the respective banks have been empowered to decide the fee. Accordingly, based on the Revised recommended scale of fees issued by the Council, an Advisory was prepared and issued to Statutory Central auditors and CFOs on 31st March, 2023.

2. RBI's Revised Circular dated 24th April 2023 (para 4):

RBI had issued a circular Ref.DoS.CO.ARG/S8213/ 08.91.001/2022-23 dated 6th March 2023 on (i) Revised Guidelines for Appointment / Re-appointment of Statutory Branch Auditors of Public Sector Banks; and (ii) Norms on Business Coverage under Statutory Branch Audit of Public Sector Banks, on which various concerns had been raised by the members on the applicability of Paragraph 4 of the said circular.

Accordingly, a representation was made by the ICAI to the RBI on the same, and the RBI has issued a revised instruction on Paragraph 4 of the said circular to the Public Sector Banks on 24th April 2023.
