- **2.** The law applicable to this contract shall be the law enforced in India. The courts of Patna Bihar shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising out of this contract

Terms & Conditions for the service for agreement: -

1. The Chartered Accountant firm must be registered with the Institute of C hartered Accountants of India (ICAI). Self-attested valid copy of CA certific ate should be enclosed.

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- 2. The firm should have at least 03 Years (Three Years) experience of providing similar taxation service to Central Govt. Departments/State Govt./Autonomous Bodies/PSU. (Please attach Proof).
- 3. Turnover of firm providing such services should not be less than 05 lakh per annum for the last three years i.e. for 2022-2023, 2023-2024 & 2024-2025.
- 4. Initially the contract will be for a period of Two Year which will be extend able to the 3rd year (will be renewed on same term & condition and rates) depending upon the satisfactory performance of the Firm.
